IQAC enquired Sri Gokul C. G Student representative about the internship program . He suggested to start internship in correct time and finish it before the examination, so that the students have sufficient time to prepare for the mandatory exams from the college

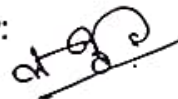
